

Review of ZoomText Express 1.0
Magnification and screen enhancement software for eyestrain relief.

This program is easy to install even if you cannot find your reading or bifocal glasses. As soon as you access the CD your computer screen will be magnified. Naturally when the screen is magnified, you must move the mouse pointer to the left if you are looking at the right hand side of the desktop to see other parts of the desktop. The installation program on the CD is only 137 MB in size. It only took approximately ten minutes for the installation and registration (on my computer). Your computer might take more or less time to do the same.

An icon for the program will be added to your desktop for easy starting of the program. When you start the program, you will see window a window that has tabs for changing the view, color, pointer and cursor. The view tab allows you decrease or increase the magnification as well as exit the program. The color tab allows you reverse all colors on the screen or apply a soft tint to white areas of the screen. The pointer tab allows you use a smaller or larger pointer in a color of your choice. The cursor tab allows you to add colored triangles to the top and bottom of the cursor.

I highly recommend the program use of the program to all computer users who must change glasses or lean closer to the screen in order to see all the words clearly. Some content on web sites are made in very small type size. I prefer to tint the background of large documents that use small type on bright background.
